## Healthy Eatery, Tossed LA, Now Open in Downtown LA Financial District

First [reported in July 2011](#), and now 8 months later, Tossed has finally crossed the finish line with an official grand opening tomorrow on Wednesday, March 14, 2012. The new healthy eatery serving up fresh varieties of salads, crepe wraps and sandwiches is located in the heart of the Financial District directly across the street from the [soaring Aon Tower](#).

I stopped by Tossed earlier today for their soft opening and was glad to see the new restaurant now open and what a difference a new business can make for an area. Tossed took over a long vacant space that used to be a bank many, many years ago. The former bank space was divided roughly in half where Famima took one side and now Tossed has taken the other. For years, this intersection sat sadly unactivated—until now. The new restaurant, with its upbeat colors and modern decor, really helps enliven the corner of Wilshire and Hope, giving this stretch of the block an extra boost in pedestrian activity.

Originally conceived in Manhattan, New York City, [Tossed](#) now has 7 locations from Boston to Vancouver and now Downtown LA. The new location is sure to be a popular spot especially for the busy lunch crowd.
